



Trumpeter **Jason Carder** grew up in Arizona and studied music at Interlochen Arts Academy and the University of Miami. He has held positions at the Mannes School of Music, Florida International University, University of Miami, and is currently jazz trumpet instructor at the University of Arizona. He currently tours extensively as the trumpet soloist with Yanni. His professional experience includes tours with

the bands of Maria Schneider, Ray Charles, Woody Herman, Maynard Ferguson, Paul Anka, K.C. and the Sunshine Band, Jaco Pastorius Big Band and the Original Wildcat Jass Band. He has contributed his talent to over eighty albums, including *Sky Blue* by Maria Schneider and *Rumba Palace, Americana*, and *Hot House* (Grammy Award Winner) by Arturo Sandoval. He is featured on Yanni's DVD *Yanni: Voices Live from the Forum in Acapulco*. He has performed on such movie soundtracks as *There's Something About Mary*, *Dirty Dancing: Havana Nights*, and *Bailando por Un Sueño*. He has appeared as featured soloist with the Florida Philharmonic Orchestra and the New World School of the Arts Big Band.



Brianne Borden lives her life as both a musician and a yoga instructor, with her passion being to meld the two art forms through her teachings of yoga for musicians. She currently serves as Teaching Assistant at Arizona State University, where she is completing her DMA degree (ABD) with a dissertation focusing on the use of yoga for brass musicians. Brianne holds degrees from the University of Colorado at Boulder (MM) and SUNY Potsdam (BM). Brianne has competed in the semifinal round of the National Trumpet Competition as both a

soloist and an ensemble member. During her time at Colorado, Brianne was a member of the Graduate Brass Quintet, who was selected to perform as featured artists in the M.D.R.E program through the Aspen Music Festival and School. She has performed with the Orchestra of Northern New York, Northern Symphonic Winds, Longmont Symphony Orchestra, Frackenpohl Honors Brass Quintet, and Clarkson Symphony Orchestra (soloist). Brianne received her 200-hour yoga training through Yoga Loft in Boulder, Colorado, with the guidance of Steph Schwartz, Jeff Bailey, and Kirsten Warner. She currently teaches at Corepower Yoga Phoenix, AZ and was the premier instructor of Yoga for Musicians at the University of Colorado through the Musician's Wellness Initiative. Brianne has also taught Yoga for Musicians at SUNY Potsdam, Crane Youth Music, and Bristol Hills Music Camp. She presented a session entitled *Yoga for Trumpet Players* at the 2016 International Trumpet Guild Conference in Anaheim, CA.
