The UND Trumpet Studio presents the 7th Annual



Dr. Dennis Edelbrock has performed with The United States Army Band and the Army Brass Quintet since 1975. Since that time, he has written music used frequently at official White House state ceremonies, NBC's "Christmas in Washington", CMT's "Nashville Now", as well as music used in the opening ceremonies for the 1984 Los Angeles Olympic Games and Special Olympics. He is the founder of The National Trumpet Competition and professor of trumpet at George Mason University, and keeps an active performing schedule in the Washington, DC area. As a professor at GMU, he was awarded the prestigious "Excellence in Teaching Award", one of only two faculty members to be recognized that year. He has presented masterclasses all over the world including the Moscow and St. Petersburg Conservatories. As principal trumpeter with the US Army Brass Quintet, he entertains at the White House and has toured in thirty-eight states as well as twelve foreign countries. The Quintet has recorded extensively and performed on National Public Radio, British Broadcasting Corporation, NBC's "Today Show," Fox Television, and Prairie Home Companion. The ensemble has been repeatedly chosen as the first to perform honors for newly inaugurated Presidents, and chosen for the Capitol Rotunda State Funeral services for Presidents Reagan and Ford during nationally telecasted events at the Capitol. The Quintet also performed in a live Russian National Television broadcast in conjunction with the Russian National Orchestra. As founder of the National Trumpet Competition, he has guided the organization in becoming the largest instrumental competition in the world, with over 12,000 student participants and \$1.5 million in prize money to date. The competition has featured numerous world-class musicians such as Canadian Brass, Arturo Sandoval, Chris Botti, Doc Severinsen, Maynard Ferguson, Allen Vizzutti, Adolph Herseth, Tim Morrison, Jamey Aebersold, Mnozil Brass, and Philip Smith just to name a few. Its website hosts online masterclasses

by many of the world's greatest artist, and it is supported by all the major trumpet manufacturers. In recent years Dr. Edelbrock has performed with the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra, Bolshoi and Kirov Ballets, New York City Ballet, American Ballet Theater, Royal Spanish Ballet, Kennedy Center Orchestra (with whom he performed the world's first web-cast as soloist in Handel's "Messiah"), Washington Opera, and the National Symphony Orchestra. He has appeared numerous times as soloist with the Kennedy Center's Washington Chamber Symphony on NPR. He is an original member of the Washington Bach Consort which holds the honor of being the only American ensemble invited to perform at the Bach Tri-Centennial in a Leipzig Gewandhaus performance which was broadcast on East German State Television. He has performed on screen as a soloist in the motion picture "Contact" (Sony Pictures), "Wag the Dog" (Miramax) and was featured on the filmscore of Tri-Star's motion picture, "Gardens of Stone". Edelbrock has also been a frequent performer on the "Discovery Channel" soundtracks. A native of Iowa City, Iowa, he is a graduate of the University of Iowa. He completed advanced studies at the Catholic University earning both a Master of Music Performance and Doctor of Music Arts degrees. He devotes as much time as possible to volunteer work with local youth groups and resides in Arlington, VA with his wife Laura, a pianist and choral director, and fifteen-year-old daughter Emma.
